**Workers' Compensation Administration Staff to Participate
in Governor's Constituent Day Event**

Albuquerque, N.M. August 7, 2019 – The New Mexico Workers' Compensation Administration will have ombudsmen, public information, constituent services and other management staff on hand at the "Governor's Cabinet in Your Community" event this Saturday. The WCA will answer general workers' compensation questions from workers and employers, and will assist in getting appropriate forms completed if necessary to pursue formal action in a workers' compensation injury claim.

Other participating agencies include the Department of Health, Human Services Department, Children, Youth and Families Department, the Motor Vehicle Division and several others. Available services will include assistance with federal government programs such as Medicaid and SNAP, free immunizations, and driver's licenses, vehicle title and registrations. The event will be from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Saturday, August 10, 2019, at the Carpenters Local 1319 Union Hall, 3900 Pan American Fwy NE, Albuquerque.
