**Workers' Compensation Advisory Council Gets New Members**

**Albuquerque, N.M. July 25, 2019** – New Mexico Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham appointed four new members to the Advisory Council on Workers' Compensation and Occupational Disease Disablement in early July.

Darrell Deaguero and Sara Ranney will represent labor, while Sharon Pedroncelli and Lillian Santillanes will represent business. Deaguero is president of Laborers Union, Local 16, the construction workers' union. Ranney is with the International Association of Firefighters Local 244, and is an engine company lieutenant. Pedroncelli is president and chief financial officer at McDade-Woodcock, Inc., a commercial electrical, instrumentation and control contractor. Santillanes is vice president of Structural Services, Inc., a steel erection firm.

Labor representative Courtenay Eichhorst was reappointed by Gov. Lujan Grisham and business representative Kevin McGinley will continue to serve out his unexpired term. Eichhorst is business manager of U.A. Local 412. And McGinley is president of McGinley Construction, Inc., a residential and commercial remodeling firm, and was elected vice chair at the Council's last meeting in April 2019.
